Your privacy

Lubbe & Sons (bulbs) Ltd. considers handling of personal data to be of great importance. That is why we want to give you clear and transparent information in this privacy policy about the way in which Lubbe & Sons (bulbs) Ltd. processes personal data of business relations with prospects, customers and visitors to our website.

Naturally, this data will be treated and protected with the utmost care. Lubbe and Son (bulbs) Ltd. comply with the General Data Protection Regulation and the GDPR Implementation Act

This means that we:

- state clearly - through this privacy statement - the purposes for which we process personal data;
- limit our collection of personal data to only the personal data needed for those purposes;
- process your personal data to implement our business objectives and ask you for permission in cases where this permission is required;
- take appropriate security measures to protect your personal data and also requirements of parties that process personal data in our order;
- respect your right to provide your personal data for inspection, correct or delete.

What we process your for.

There are various purposes for which Lubbe & Sons (bulbs) Ltd collects and processes your data. As part of her service towards clients, Lubbe & Sons (bulbs) Ltd for this purpose contact details, including your name, job title, business mobile telephone number and business email address:

Cookies:

We use cookies for statistical evaluation purposes. Cookies are files that can be placed on your computer's hard drive to make navigation easier. The means that you don't have to enter all the data required for use every time you visit the site. Cookies also help us to tailor our website to your specific needs, e.g. your national language or preferred areas of interest. If you do not want this, you simply need to activate the decline cookies option in your browser. Most browsers accept cookies automatically but allow you to decline cookies or to display a warning before saving them. To find out how this works, please consult the instructions for your browser. You can delete cookies already set on your computer at any time. However, if you do not accept cookies, this can restrict the functions available on our site.

Publication of data:

Your data will be treated confidential and not be published.

Supply of data to third parties:

Unless expressly indicated in this declaration, your data will not be shared with third parties except in cases where there is a legal obligation to do so or data has to be transmitted in order to implement the contractual relationship. External service providers and partner businesses, such as online payment providers only receive your data insofar as this is necessary to process your order. In such cases, the scope of the data transmitted is kept to the minimum essentials. If our service providers come in contact with your personal data on our behalf, we ensure that they comply with the requirements of data protection legislation to the same extent. You should also note the data protection information supplied by the provider. The service provider is responsible for the content of external services and we take all reasonable steps to verify that the services comply with legal requirements.

Google Analytics:

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses so-called "cookies", text files that are stored on your computer and that make it possible to analyse the way you use the website. As a rule, the information generated by the cookie about your use of this website is transmitted to a Google server in the USA and stored there.
